TABView Internet and EFORM Internet – Data, CPU Dimension and Electrical Specs

Disclaimer - Read First !

It is assumed that your IT personnel (or persons responsible for your internet router/service) have read the following and understand the requirement **pre installation**. Any post installation service calls or configuration changes to the Tabview system (for example reconfiguration of IP numbers) will be at your venues cost. This public internet PC is a locked system and does not allow network settings access, once locked. If your venue's policy prevents such connections to your internal router, it's strongly recommended to install a dedicated router for your TAB area on a separate line. Popular services such as Tabview Internet, Flexicast and Mytab (wall sheets) all require an unrestricted internet feed. With routers now available for under \$100 (plus ISP charges) your venue can actually save in IT company management fees over the longer term, and prevent TAB service outages with this approach.

Specs

- 2 power points or 1 double GPO in lower section of cabinet (1 for PC and 1 for Monitor) **per system**
- 1 CATS R.J45 Data Cable, terminated with MALE R.J45 connectors to be run between your broadband internet router and the lower section of computer housing. (Please test cable with CATS tester). **1 Cable per system.**
- Broadband Router must be setup as a DHCP server with no restrictions on the selected port. (Please advise if not configured in this manner) Tabview and EFORM systems by default are set to auto obtain IP and DNS.
- No Firewall Restrictions, no IP restrictions, no DNS restrictions, DHCP server enabled.

Connection can be easily tested with a *non-venue specific laptop PC, if you can browse the Internet from the customer/sports unit location, then the cable is ready for Tabview Internet and EFORM. *(non-venue specific meaning the laptop is not normally in use within the venue and likely to have been configured specially for the router).

Please note that we do not supply patch leads with systems. If the Electrician terminates the cabling to wall sockets, please ensure that he leaves the appropriate (tested) patch leads.

** All Quotations assume that all electrical and joinery work is completed prior to our technicians attending site. Non completion of these specifications will result in a secondary service call, and secondary service charge.

37cm Depth (plus 15-20cm for ventilation and cable access) 9cm Height (plus 15-20cm for ventilation)
32 cm Wide (plus 15-20cm for ventilation)

USB MOUSE HOLE FOR TABVIEW INTERNET

USB Mouse requires a 15mm hole through bench or joinery.

***ALL PC ENCLOSURES REQUIRE ADEQUATE VENTILATION.**-Enclosed wooden joinery must have vents.

Non ventilated units will void manufacturer's warranty and are noted at installation. Cupboard should have a door to allow staff to switch unit on and off daily.
